01 Your Opening Plenary Tickets ACTION REQUIRED

As an exhibitor, you are entitled to **two complimentary tickets to the Opening Plenary** on the morning of Tuesday, June 9, the ceremonial start to the show, where senior political and industry leadership frame Canada's role in the global energy system. The session opens with remarks from the Hon. Tim Hodgson, Minister of Energy and Natural Resources, Government of Canada.

How to claim your two tickets

The cost of these tickets is **already included in the price of your exhibit space**. Your salesperson will be in touch to confirm whether your team will be using them. Because seating is **extremely limited**, tickets must be claimed **in advance of show open**, once capacity is reached, we are unable to add additional seats.

11 A Friendly Reminder on Communication Security

dmg events has issued a formal advisory regarding fraudulent activity targeting participants of our major events, including Global Energy Show Canada. These third parties are not affiliated with dmgevents and frequently attempt to sell fraudulent attendee lists or offer unauthorised accommodation services.

Common Scam Tactics

- **Attendee or exhibitor list sales** — unsolicited emails offering 2026 contact lists. dmgevents never sells attendee contact information.
- **Hotel and travel scams** — unauthorised companies arranging accommodation on your behalf, often demanding pre-payment.
- **Fraudulent directories** — requests to confirm a company listing in directories that do not exist.

How to Protect Your Organisation

- **Verify the sender.** Confirm any email from our team ends in **@dmgevents.com**.
- **Do not engage** with suspicious links or attachments from unsolicited emails.
- **Use official channels only.** Book exclusively through partners listed on the event website.

If you receive a suspicious communication, please do not reply. Report it to our team using the contact details below — we will investigate and follow up promptly.
